## WINTER WEATHER EMERGENCY DECLARATION OF LOCAL DISASTER

WHEREAS, the City of Floresville on the 18<sup>TH</sup> day of February has suffered threats to life, health and property due to a major winter storm that has impacted the City of Floresville and has caused freezing temperatures, snow and ice accumulations. This storm has prevented access and safe passage on roadways, and caused long-term electrical power and utility outages, thus creating a public safety hazard.

WHEREAS, I, Cecelia "Cissy" Gonzalez-Dippel, Mayor of the City of Floresville have determined that extraordinary measures must be taken to alleviate the suffering of people and to protect or rehabilitate property;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT PROCLAIMED BY THE MAYOR OF THE CITY OF FLORESVILLE:

- 1. That a state of disaster is declared for the City of Floresville, Texas pursuant to section 418.108(a) of the Texas Government Code.
- 2. Pursuant to section 418.108(b) of the Texas Government Code, the state of disaster shall continue for a period of not more than seven days from the date of this declaration unless continued or renewed by the Floresville City Council, Texas.
- 3. Pursuant to section 418.108(c) of the Texas Government Code, this declaration of a local state of disaster shall be given prompt and general publicity and shall be filed promptly with the City Secretary.
- 4. Pursuant to section 418.108(d) of the Texas Government Code, a declaration of local disaster activates the appropriate recovery and rehabilitation aspects of all applicable local or interjurisdictional emergency management plans and authorizes the furnishing of aid and assistance under the declaration.

5. This Declaration shall take effect immediately.
