Position Summary:

Under general supervision, performs a wide variety of skilled and semi-skilled building maintenance and repair tasks; and performs related duties as required.

Essential Duties and Responsibilities:

The following duties ARE NOT intended to serve as a comprehensive list of all duties performed by all employees in this classification, only a representative summary of the primary duties and responsibilities.

- Sweeps, vacuums, mops, scrubs, waxes and polishes floors using industrial vacuum cleaners and scrubbing and buffing machines.
- Uses ladders, dusts and washes walls, cleans ceilings and dusts and polishes light fixtures
- Light electrical and plumbing work may be required
- Light repair or replacement maintenance may be required
- Must complete regular checklists on building maintenance procedures and keep record of procedures performed on all building parts
- Basic building housecleaning: *clean restrooms, removal of trash, change air filters, replace light bulbs*
- Physical setup of tables and chairs to meet requirements and contractual agreements within the constraints of safety, health, and fire code standards
- Maintain landscape: mow, weed trim, water lawn, pick up liter
