Questions & Responses

Question:

For the purposes of evaluation, does the City consider experience designing and managing complex, public-facing platforms for government partners, quasi-government entities, or publicly funded initiatives to be comparable to municipal website experience?

Response:

Question:

Does the City currently use external platforms for services such as online payments, job applications, recreation/event registration, emergency notifications, or volunteer management? If so, should the website integrate with these systems, or is the expectation to build these capabilities natively within the CMS?

Response:

We have payment portals for utility billing and municipal court. We will need to establish a payment portal for the permitting department.

Question:

For publicly warned meetings and document management, can you provide more detail on expectations for agendas, minutes, video integration, archival access, and compliance requirements? Additionally, should documents be searchable by keyword (including within PDFs), category, and date?

Response:

Yes, refer to current website at floresvilletx.gov for minimum data application. Yes, documents should be searchable by keyword (including within PDFs), category, and date?

Question:

Can you clarify the expected functionality of the document and archive search, specifically whether the system should support full-text search within PDFs and other files, include filtering by criteria such as department or date, and require migration and indexing of existing documents into a centralized searchable repository?

Response:

Yes, city is moving towards using civic clerk, so we'd like to have our web team become familiar with civic clerks' software and inquires of the civic clerk software.

Question:

Is there an anticipated budget range or funding allocation for this project that proposers should be aware of when developing their approach?

This project should not exceed \$50,000.00.
