**June 12<sup>th</sup> to June 16<sup>th</sup>** – Exploring the “Land Down Under” starts with **South Australia**. Here we can check out the outback and it’s people, the Aborigines. We can visit Kangaroo Island! Did you know a Kangaroo’s baby is a Joey? We can play a game of Australian soccer.

**June 19<sup>th</sup> to June 23<sup>th</sup>** - Discovering Australia’s animals and native plants is one of the highlights for this week when we visit **Queensland** and the Daintree Rain Forest. We can learn how to play Cricket.

**June 26<sup>th</sup> to June 29<sup>th</sup>** – While we are in **Queensland** we will check out the Great Barrier Reef with its breathtaking array of marine creatures. Sharks, whales, crocodiles and dolphins are only few of the creatures we will be exploring.

**July 10<sup>th</sup> to July 14<sup>th</sup>** – - It is believed that the **dingo** is descended from the Asian wolf and it is thought they arrived in Australia 18,300 years ago. We will check out the **Western Australian** wild dogs, called Dingo. We can learn how to play Net Ball.

**July 17<sup>th</sup> to July 21<sup>st</sup>** – Going to the **Northern Territory** in Australia is where we will check out some of the world’s biggest crocodiles and then we can learn how to play Rugby.

**July 24<sup>th</sup> to July 27<sup>th</sup>** – **New Zealand** is next and we will learn about the kea, a native bird who is known for pulling windscreen wipers off cars and eating the strips of rubber from windows. Can you say this word? It is the longest name in the world: Taumatawhakatangihangakoauauotamateapokaiwhenuakitanatahu, in New Zealand

**Basketball** accepts children between the ages of 4-5 (Kinder League), 6-7 (Youth League), 8-9 (Intermediate League), 10-12 (Junior League) and 13-18 (Senior League). Practices are scheduled for Monday and Wednesday, starting June 5<sup>th</sup>, games are played on Thursday and Friday nights starting July 6<sup>th</sup>. Registration Fee is \$60.00 and late fee will be charged starting June 5<sup>th</sup>. This league depends on volunteer parent coaches and fundraiser participation.

**Summer Day Camp** accepts children between the ages of 5-13 years old and starts on June 12<sup>th</sup>. Camp starts at 8:00 am and ends at 6:00 pm. The dates of Camp are listed on the back of this sheet of paper. The campers are feed breakfast, lunch and afternoon snacks. **Our Theme this summer is Australia.** This is a cognitive program where campers will be participating in fun learning. Registration fee includes Breakfast, Lunch, and afternoon snacks, \$125 per week for first child, \$100 per week for Second sibling and \$90 per week for Third sibling.
